Special Educational Needs & Disabilities : Where the Funding is spent...

EYFS Support.

Cost:£4,000

Aim: Improve basic language and maths skills. Provide experiences to extend social skills, making children ready to learn.

Outcome: Percentage of children making good or better progress maintained.

Continuing Professional Development

Cost:£1800 SENCo CPD / £1000

Aim: to provide staff (teachers and Teaching Assistants) with the skills to develop the curriculum for pupils needs .

Outcome: Increased confidence and attainment in reading, Writing and Maths for high or low attaining disadvantaged children that historically underperform.

Educational Psychologist

Cost:£7,500

Aim: Targeted assessments to support the SENCo in allocation of provision for pupils with additional needs.

Outcome: Parents and the SENCo to have accurate assessments in order to support individual pupil provision.

TA Support including 1 to 1 and class based

Cost:£55,790

Aim: Targeted support for pupils with EHCP and Wave 2&3 pupils..

Outcome: Children make good or better progress. Good percentages in Phonic screening Check, KS1 end of Key Stage assessments and KS2 End of Key Stage assessments are maintained. Pupils to meet their individual targets on during their annual review.

Welfare

Cost:£3408

Aim: To provide opportunities for disadvantaged children to improve their social and behaviour skills through play during lunchtimes.

Outcome: Children will be able to enjoy lunchtimes and play co-operatively together. Incidents involving conflict will be significantly reduced.

Knowsley Central Support

Cost:£19,583

Aim: Provide Wave 2 & 3 children with targeted support (weekly). To provide fun and excitement which leads to motivation for learning. To assess progress and support class teacher and teaching assistant planning overtime.

Outcome: Children and parents to have accurate assessment and progress information. Motivation and confidence will feed into their learning.
